

# Let's define the key players!



- Ayres Sensory Integration:
  - Sensory Integration framework created specifically by Jean Ayers
- Sensory Integration:
  - How we experience, interpret and react to (or ignore) information coming from our senses
- Sensory Regulation/Processing:
  - How you appropriately respond to incoming sensory information

#### Sensory Modulation Disorders

**Sensory Over-Responsivity/hyperresponsiveness** (over exaggerated responses); escalate with very little input

**Sensory Under-Responsivity/hyporesponsiveness**- Takes an unusually intense amount of input to get the same response (under sensitive)

**Sensory Seeking/Craving -** A child obtains sensory information via showing interest or pleasure with certain sensations and seek them out

# Sensory - Based Motor Disorders

Definition: poor posture and movement due to difficulty interpreting sensory information

#### Types:

- Postural Disorder: Deficits in vestibular and proprioceptive input impact stabilization of movement and at rest
- 2. **Dyspraxia**: difficulty with initiating, coordinating and executing motor action


# Sensory Discrimination Disorder

Definition: difficulty differentiating sensory input and quality provided

Impacts all senses
